### **Woodperry Hill / Straight Mile Road, Horton-cum-Studley Carriageway Maintenance Works**

I am writing to inform you that Oxfordshire County Council will be undertaking carriageway maintenance work on Straight Mile Road, Horton-cum-Studley, between Woodperry Hill and Horton Hill.

The works are programmed to start on **Monday 7 August 2017** and are expected to last for six weeks, subject to any bad weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances during construction.

The works will include structural repairs to failed road edges, resurfacing of the existing carriageway, drainage improvements, kerb and footway repairs and the replacement of road markings.

### **Traffic Management**

To enable these activities to be carried out safely, the work will be carried out under a road closure. However, in order to keep traffic disruption to a minimum, the work will be done in the following phases:

- Phase 1: Monday 7 August to Friday 1 September – full road closure between Woodperry Hill and Studley Wood Golf Club
- Phase 2: Monday 4 September to Friday 15 September – full road closure between Studley Wood Golf Club and Horton Hill

A signed diversion route will be put in place during the above phases which will direct traffic via Oakley Road, Mill Street, Stanton St John and the B4027 and vice versa, see attached plan for details.

Staff will be positioned at either end of the closure to direct traffic and pedestrians to ensure the safety of the public and workforce. We ask that you give them your full support whether you are a pedestrian, cyclist or motorist.

Every effort will be made to accommodate vehicular access to properties and businesses within and adjacent to the works but this may be subject to some delay depending on the activities being carried out on site. Again, I ask for your support during these periods.
